September

2: Put-in-Bay, Ohio — Bicentennial of the Battle of Lake Erie. Eighteen tall ships join the cast, recalling the War of 1812.

7-21: San Francisco — America's Cup. The wing's the thing, as high-tech boats compete.

13-21: Bath, England — Jane Austen Festival. Grand Regency Costumed Parade launches an Austen odyssey.

14-30: Kosice, Slovakia, to Marseille, France — Transart Communication Performance Art Festival. "Art train" connects Europe's two Capitals of Culture 2013.

17-22: Bardstown, Ky. — Kentucky Bourbon Festival. Premier distilleries pour it on.

27: Antwerp, Belgium — Opening of the Red Star Line Museum. Displays document the shipping line that ferried millions to America.

October

6-9: Hong Kong — Fine Art Asia. Museum-quality work spans 5,000 years.

10-12: Denver — Great American Beer Festival. Mile-high suds flow from 580 breweries.

10-13: Ketchum, Idaho — Trailing of the Sheep. Rams, lambs and ewes parade down Main Street.

27: Kapalua, Maui — XTERRA World Championship. Off-road triathlon combines swimming, mountain biking and trail running.
